The academic program officially began in January 2017.

ABOUT THE FOUNDER MIKI WATANABE



Miki Watanabe (born October 5, 1959) is a distinguished member of the House of Councillors in Japan and the founder of Watami Inc. In 1984, Mr. Watanabe embarked on his entrepreneurial journey by acquiring a struggling restaurant franchise and establishing Watami. Under his leadership, Watami went public on the Tokyo Stock Exchange in 2000.

In addition to his business ventures, Mr. Watanabe is deeply committed to education and healthcare. He oversees junior high schools in Japan, Bangladesh, and Cambodia, and manages a hospital in Osaka. He is also the founder of "School Aid Japan (SAJ)," a non-profit organization dedicated to educational support.

In 2011, Mr. Watanabe garnered over a million votes in his campaign for Governor of Tokyo, showcasing strong support from the community. Nevertheless, he was appointed as a counselor for the reconstruction of Rikuzentakata, an area affected by a major earthquake.

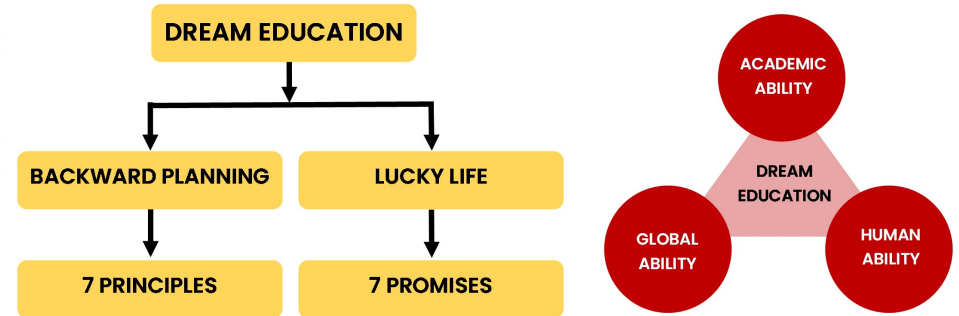
In April 2006, Watami restructured into a holding company, expanding its operations into diverse sectors including restaurants, nursing care facilities, food catering for the elderly, merchandising, agriculture, and environmental initiatives. As of August 2018, Watami operates 725 restaurants, 94 nursing care facilities, 502 food catering offices, and manages a 780-hectare farm. The company's mission is to be recognized as "the world's best company for collecting the most 'Thank you's' from people worldwide" within 100 years.

In 2013, Mr. Watanabe was elected to the Upper House after receiving 104,176 votes from supporters across Japan. He now focuses on fostering the growth of small and medium-sized businesses, retail merchants, and venture enterprises, with a strong emphasis on the development of a substantial economy.

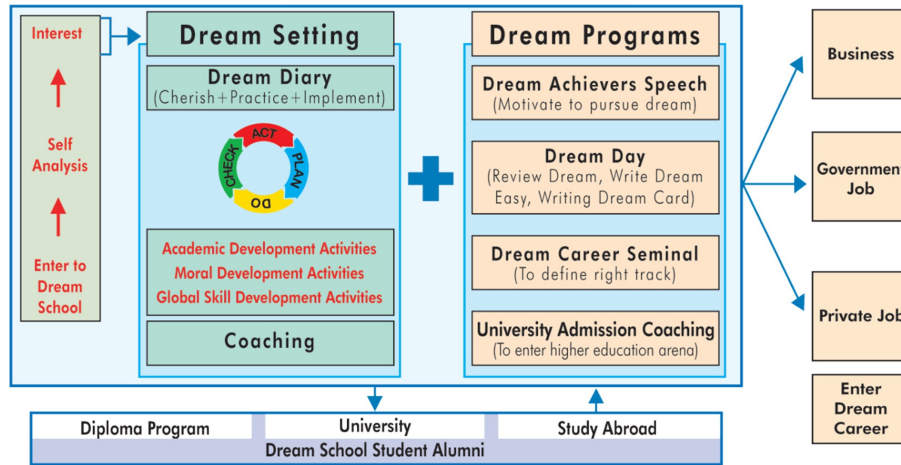

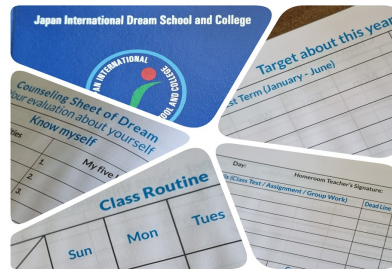

Sports Festival

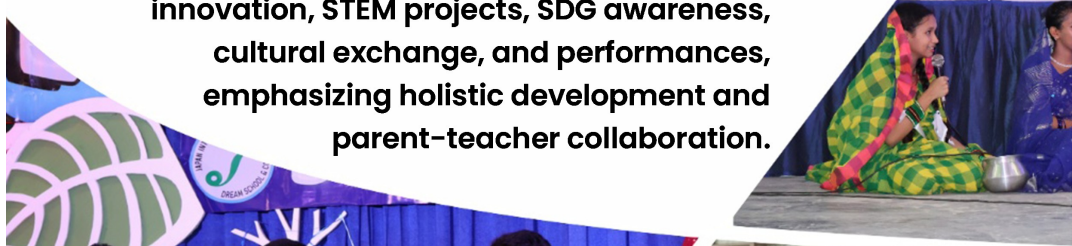
